

Clearwater Beach

Spread along a narrow, 3-mile stretch of the Pinellas Peninsula on the Gulf Coast, Clearwater Beach straddles the blue waters of the Gulf of Mexico to the west, and tranquil Tampa Bay to the east. Restrooms and restaurants are available.

If you're feeling adventuresome, jump aboard the hop-on-and-off Jolly Trolley to ride throughout Clearwater Beach. Exact change is required for the trolley. You can purchase a senior pass for all day use of Trolley at the visitor centers at entrance to pier 60.

The beach amenities include cabanas and chairs for rent on the beach (2 chairs and umbrella = \$30. They do not rent individual umbrellas or chairs. You can add an extra chair for \$10.) No lockers are available to store personal items. The Beach is open for enjoying; you can come and go into the event with the wristband. Many Restaurants are in walking distance. This is a public beach. No alcohol is allowed but there are many bars and restaurants nearby.
