If needed, seats will be distributed by lottery. Notice of bus assignments will be provided by June 1st. If you are not chosen, we will contact you to see if you wish to be put on the wait list. If you want to ride with a spouse or a bus partner, please sign up together with one check. This way you will be assigned together.

Only 2 seats can sign up (enter lottery) together. All NBBC trips are Non-refundable, participate at your own risk. If you want to request seats with other members please read the trip registrations form attached (or print from our website northernbeachbums.org)

<u>Trip Description:</u> Manatee Beach is located on Anna Maria Island on the Gulf of Mexico. Anna Maria Island is known for its beautiful, sandy, broad beaches. A free trolley is available to transport you around the island to explore shops, galleries, museums and restaurants.

The <u>beach amenities</u> include lifeguards, chair/umbrella rentals, changing stalls, restrooms, and a lunch/snack bar at the edge of the beach. Manatee Public beach is a dry beach, no alcohol permitted, but there is a Tiki Hut for adult beverages next to the gift/beach shop. **Chair/umbrella rentals are not guaranteed and may be sold out** before our arrival.

As always on an NBBC trip; you will be on your own for the afternoon. You can enjoy the beach or explore the island. The free trolley stops every 3-4 blocks (Gratuity Appreciated). Jump on the trolley at Manatee Public Beach and exit the trolley at one of the most frequented areas; Crescent Drive at Pine Avenue. You can enjoy an abundance of restaurants, shops, boutiques, art galleries, jewelry shops and more. You can also visit the Anna Marie Island Historical Society. Admission is free, donations are accepted. Next door is the Old City Jail built in 1927. It burned down in the 1940s, but the remaining structure is one of the most photographed attractions on the island.
