If needed, seats will be distributed by lottery. Notice of bus assignments will be provided by February 1st. If you are not chosen, we will contact you to see if you wish to be put on a wait list. If you want to ride with a spouse or bus partner, please sign up together with one check. This way you will be assigned together. **Only 2 seats can sign up (enter lottery) together.** All NBBC trips are non-refundable. Participate at your own risk. If you want to request seats with other members, please read the trip registration form.

TRIP DESCRIPTION:

Anastasia State Park covers 1600 acres of beaches, tidal marshes, the historic coquina quarry, and nature trails for hiking. The State Park is located on the Great Florida Birding and Wildlife Trail. It has 4 miles of beach on the Atlantic coastline. There is a designated swimming area but there are NO LIFEGUARDS AFTER LABOR DAY. Alcohol from home is prohibited but can be purchased from the Island Beach Shop and Grille. Entering the sand dunes, which are protected wildlife areas, is also prohibited.

BEACH AMENITIES:

The Island Beach Shop and Grille offers burgers, wraps, sandwiches, salads, sweet treats, beer, wine, and frozen drinks. There are outside picnic tables with complimentary wi-fi. They also offer beach supplies, souvenirs, bicycle, boogie board, chair and umbrella rentals. There are restrooms and an outdoor shower.

RENTALS:

The Island Beach shop and Grille has a limited supply of chairs and umbrellas to be rented on a first come, first served basis so it is recommended to **BRING YOUR OWN CHAIRS/UMBRELLAS.** Anastasia Water Sports offers canoes, kayaks, standup paddleboards, and canoe rentals. https://anastasiawatersports.com/home/plan-your-day/beachactivities

EXCURSION TO ST AUGUSTINE HISTORIC DISTRICT:

Your Choice! Spend the Day in St. Augustine (approximately 6.5 hours) or enjoy the beach and then just under 3 hours in St. Augustine. You can decide the day of the trip. If you choose to spend time at both the beach and St. Augustine, you will have time for dinner but not much else. St Augustine is a beautiful city. Ponce De Leon arrived there in 1513 in search of the Fountain of Youth. It is the oldest continuously occupied city in the US. There are many restaurants, pubs, shops, museums, and attractions. Some examples would be the Castillo de San Marcos Fort, Fountain of Youth, Ripley's Believe it or not, Lightner Museum, St Augustine Distillery, Flagler College, and Old Town Trolley Tours. There are many chartered boat tours from the marina in St. Augustine if you want to spend some time on the water. The historical trolley tour is highly recommended if this is your first visit. You might check out the hop on off trolley ticket options and take a ride out to the lighthouse. St Augustine offer a variety of tourist attractions and tours.

This event involves walking. It is quite a distance from the bus depot drop off to St. George Street. If you are planning on utilizing the hop on/off trolley you will need to walk from bus depot across the park to the hop on/off trolley. Please be prepared with walking shoes.
