St Petersburg pier is a landmark extending into Tampa Bay from downtown St. Petersburg. <u>https://stpetepier.org/</u>. Located on the city's picturesque waterfront, it is 26 beautiful acres combining peaceful blue water of Tampa Bay with the vibrant greenery of down town St. Petersburg parks. Stroll, dine, drink, shop, explore the museums or take a dolphin boat ride; all in walking distance or trolley ride from the pier. If needed, seats will be distributed by lottery. Notice of bus assignments will be provided by February 1st. If you are not chosen, we will contact you. If you want to ride with a spouse or a bus partner, please sign up together with one check. Only 2 members can sign up (enter lottery) together. If you want to request seats on the same bus as other members, make sure those members are going, and make sure those member(s) also place your name on their registration form. Read the trip registrations form and follow the instructions. No guarantee can be given that we will match up members on the bus, but we do our best.

TRIP INFO:

Our adventure will begin as our buses drop us off near St. Pete Pier at South Staub Park. The pier is a landmark pleasure pier extending into Tampa Bay from downtown St. Petersburg. <u>https://stpetepier.org/</u>. It's more than just a PIER. It's and exPIERience. Located on the city's picturesque waterfront. Its 26 beautiful acres combining peaceful blue water of Tampa Bay with the vibrant greenery of down town St. Petersburg parks. Stroll, dine, drink, shop, explore the museums or take a boat ride; all in walking distance or trolley ride from the pier. Last time we were at the pier in 2023 they even had a shuttle to take you to then of the pier. We will check before our trip to find out if that service is still available. There is some walking even with the trolleys pick up directly across the street from where buses normally drop off, be prepared.

Take a stroll thru Staub Park or explore the pier <u>https://stpetepier.org/explore/</u> or grab some drinks and food at Spa Beach Bistro, Doc Fords Rum Bar & Grille, Pier Teak, Driftwood, Care Fresco's, or Waterfront Bistro. You can visit St. Petersburg Museum of History, The Museum of Fine Arts in north Straub Park, or located on the over-water walkway approaching the St. Pete Pier is the Discovery Center. 2,000 sf of exhibits that tell the story of Tampa Bay's unique ecosystem. Interactive Exhibits, free and affordable daily programs are available. <u>https://www.tbwdiscoverycenter.org/eco-tours</u>. Take a ride on the Trolly's available in St. Petersburg to shops, galleries, museums, and restaurants. Trolly's run every 20-30 minutes, so planning is essential. The Central Ave Trolley departs from the Pier where we will be dropped off and you can ride for as little as 50 cents within the Grand Central Station area or beyond for \$2.25 (or Seniors with ID get half off at \$1.10) <u>https://www.psta.net/media/1006/central-avenue-trolley.pdf</u> all the way to Passe-a-Grille beach on the beautiful waters of the Gulf Coast. Enjoy lunch on the beach, rent a chair or take a stroll.

Central Avenue is the heart of St. Petersburg and we recommend riding the Central Ave Trolley to visit the amazing art glass galleries and museums on what's known as Florida's glass coast. The Chihuly Collection by artist Dale Chihuly is a special treat and located across from the Morean Arts Center, <u>https://moreanartscenter.org/</u>, The Chihuly ticket price also includes admission to the Morean Glass Studio and Hot Shop glass blowing demonstration. If you plan to visit this exhibit, it is strongly suggested that you order your ticket online. The Chihuly will be take about 45 minutes and the Hot shop will be about 30-45 minutes depending on your interests.

The Dali Museum, <u>https://thedali.org/</u>, you will see the unparalleled works of renowned artist Salvador Dali. It has been the unofficial heart of fine arts in the Tampa Bay Area since it's opening in 1982. Advanced ticket purchase is recommended and include access to all galleries. It will take about 2 hours and the self guided tour is recommended.

The Imagine Museum <u>https://www.imaginemuseum.com</u> showcases a spectacular collection of glass art around the world both American contemporary and International artists. The museum suggest to allow 2 hours to tour depending your interest and appreciation for glass art.

If you are interested in shopping you may want to visit the mall at Sundial, <u>https://sundialstpete.com/</u>, Just steps away from the waterfront. It features a nearly 3 story working Sundial and fountain. It offers dining options as well. Also you can just stroll along Central Ave and visit it's many boutiques, restaurants and bars <u>https://www.visitstpeteclearwater.com/central-ave</u>
