Seat(s) purchase for our next trip to New Smyrna Beach, FL on Wednesday May 6th are NOW AVAILABLE. Seats are sold first come first serve. Purchase availability will close on May 20th or when we have buses filled, whichever happens first. If we overfill the buses OR can not fill up bus #2, we will contact you to advise of refund. Sales are first come/serve. We no longer have a lottery. SEATS ARE FOR SALE ONLINE ONLY: *****

Purchase options:

- **One seat alone \$30 (seat partner to be matched up at bus);**
- **Two seats on one payment seated together \$60. We no longer will be sorting sign-ups to match you to partners or group requests to be on the same bus. IF YOU WANT TO SIT WITH SOMEONE, SIGN UP TOGETHER.**
- **Be careful when you sign up to complete information and choose on the purchase page the QUANTITY AND PRICE for 1 seat @\$30 or 2 seats @\$60 before you purchase.**
- **Only enter the names, emails, cell # s of the members you are purchasing seats for. Please do not enter names of your friends who purchased a seat separately!**

You can join up with your friends at the beach. Members only. Guests will only be allowed to book after we confirm if there is space for them.

New Smyrna Beach (at Flagler Ave) Florida

Trip Description:

Located on Florida's Central Atlantic Coast and under 2 hours from The Villages. New Smyrna Beach has firm sand, is very wide, and simply a great place to walk, catch a little sun or just relax. The beach is very clean and has clean public restrooms close by. There are several restaurants and shops within an easy walk down Flagler Avenue. Known for its coastal architecture and personality, New Smyrna Beach is a prime location for visitors looking for a laidback community filled with hidden adventures. The area is surrounded by intriguing history, artistic talents, one-of-a-kind boutiques, local eateries.

The beach amenities include lifeguards, outside shower, and clean restrooms, dressing rooms. New Smyrna Beach is a dry beach, no alcohol permitted, but there are numerous restaurants and bars on the beach and on Flagler Ave. The closest bar is at The Breakers on the beach. We are trying to confirm if rentals are still available at the beach, more info will be provided when we send out confirmations.

Safety Warnings: New Smyrna Beach at Flagler Avenue Beach is drivable. Be careful when crossing the designated driving path. Volusia County beaches are known for shark sightings. Sharks are occasionally in the area typically at dusk and usually further down the beaches at surfer locations. It is occasional, but you should note to swim at your own risk near the lifeguard and be aware of your surroundings.

As always on an NBBC trip; you will be on your own for the afternoon. You can enjoy the beach or cool off and explore Flagler Ave where you can enjoy an abundance of restaurants, shops, boutiques, art galleries, jewelry shops and more. We board for home at 3:30pm.
